Profit sharing benefits those who have already delivered timber to the association, as well as those who will deliver to us in the future.

Local knowledge with a personal touch

We operate close to our members' forests in order to offer the best possible advice and support. Being local creates security for members who live further away from their businesses.

Every member is assigned a personal forest inspector who is a forestry management specialist in the area where their forest is located. The inspector is on hand to assist owners in reaching their individual goals.

Each member belongs to a local forestry area (called a sbo), depending on where their forest is located. In each forestry area a 'sbo council' consisting of elected members organizes local member activities and supports field staff and fellow members. Every member has the opportunity to get involved in the association and influence its direction.



Our Services

We offer advice, knowledge and services in all aspects of forest ownership. Regardless of how much forest you own, your previous forestry experience or what you need help with, we will always be here to support you.

- Business services: forest ownership plan, forest ownership agreement, forest ownership strategy, forestry management, PEFC environmental certification.
- Forestry management services: soil preparation, planting, clearing, thinning, fertilizing, regeneration felling, ditching.
- **Financial services:** economic and legal forestry services: valuations, cash flow, financing, consulting and change of ownership advice.
- Real estate brokerage: selling or buying land, valuations.
- Road office: road services including: new construction, road maintenance, share calculations, etc.
- Forestry school: theoretical training in, among other things: 'value-creating forestry', 'your forest economy' and 'the cycle of a working forest'. In-depth practical training in forest clearing and the use of chainsaws.



It's free to become a member

It costs nothing to become a member. Instead you pay a capital investment that remains your own money and builds up over time.

The capital investment is based on your forest holding and can range from a minimum of SEK 2,000 to a maximum of SEK 80,000. Your capital investment constitutes your personal share of ownership in the association, which is managed by the association during your time as a member and paid out should you want to leave.

Our members' combined capital investments constitute

the financial foundation of the association's operations.

How to apply

Membership levels

Ordinary member- you own a forest in Norra Skog's area of operation.

Family member - for relatives of an ordinary member. Not eligible for profit sharing. Cost: SEK 1,000.

Senior member- for ordinary members who have sold their business. Eligible for profit sharing.

Agreement, you'll get access to a
map with detailed information about
your land. You can read about any
proposed measures and follow the
development of your forest in detailfrom the height of your pine trees
to the moisture content of your soil.
You can even pin the location of a
handy cold spring (and the ideal
location for mushroom picking and
family outings).

If you have signed a Forest Ownership Agreement you will also receive a copy of 'My Forest Overview' - which details your forest's development and finances. It even tells you how much your forest's annual growth is contributing to carbon dioxide absorption.

As a member, you are also a co-owner of Husum Pulp AB, where


pulpwood and chips from our sawmills are transformed into climate-friendly products. Any by-products are used by turbines and turned into 'green' electricity.

- Get a fast response and professional service in the event of any discrepancy/complaint.
